Schedule:

6:45 a.m.: Load the bus. Location to be determined

10:00 a.m.- 12:00 p.m.: Tour National Parts Depot

12:00 p.m.–1:30 p.m. Lunch and travel to Don Garlits Museum

1:30 p.m.–NLT 4:00 p.m. Tour Garlit's Museum

4:00 p.m.: Load the bus for return trip

7:00 p.m.: Arrive back at Tallahassee

Travel Details:

Travel time will be approximately 2.5 hours

The bus will be provided by Astro Travel, The bus has USB ports and a 110 volt outlet at each seat. There is also a restroom.

Light snacks and drinks with lids are permitted. Fast food is not allowed.

Tipping the driver a few bucks is considered appropriate.

Cost:

With the club contributing \$750.00 toward the cost of the trip, individual costs will depend on occupancy. With a full bus of 38 the cost per person will be \$35.00. If only 30 people signed up, the cost would be \$45.00 each.
